Aust & Hachmann Canada very proudly announced this year the construction of their 6th primary school. The village is called Namohana and it's in the Antalaha district; heart of the vanilla communities of Madagascar. The local construction company **Enterprise Herimanana** shares our vision of providing improved access to education for the rural communities of the vast vanilla region in Madagascar. *Misaotra an'i Construction Herimanana!*



A magnificent initiative by Sentrex Ingredients...

...we built a cyclone safe concrete elementary school in Andrakidilana, a very remote vanilla growing village without access to the main road. With the volunteer help of many villagers, the materials were all transported safely and successfully. This required a lot of manual labour as once the road ends, the only way to get to the village is by foot through the forest, rivers and streams.

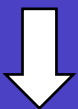
Until this structure, Andrakadilana didn't have certified teachers paid by the state. The teachers were always paid by FRAM -The Parents Association. Of course, this is common in remote villages. However, when news got out about the new school in September, CISCO - Circonscription scolaire (school district) decided to send a paid certified teacher to the village to live and work. He has now officially settled in the village with his family. He also took on the role of school principal. To top it off, this news almost doubled the amount of children's attendance! Also, this is the first concrete structure ever erected in the village.

Solar power and running water are now working properly and as a result of Herimanana's repairs. A fresh coat of paint and many other improvements. The health clinic was recently assigned a nurse, paid by the state, as well as a guardian that watches over the clinic and all its valuables.

Herimanana Construction revamped Aust & Hachmann Canada's schools which began to deteriorate much earlier than expected. Sponsoring the construction of schools in Madagascar takes time and requires patience, but the benefits are immeasurable and limitless.

Ertice Iarozafy (JHA's Manager in Madagascar) together with his assistants, have now trained a total of 472 elementary school teachers in the Kit Mad'ERE methodology and 219 Kit Mad'ERE backpacks have been distributed and taken back to community classrooms in the SAVA region. This all converts to over 30,000 students per year being exposed to Kit Mad'ERE in the vanilla growing region (primary level classes host anywhere from 50 to 80 students per classroom).

I would also like to acknowledge all the participants in the SAVA region; from the children who happily partake in learning, to their parents who hear all about their awareness, to the professionals -teachers, school principles and ZAP leaders who offer their time and skills to be trained in the program, all the way to our front-runners in Antananarivo at GIZ + our Kit Mad'Ere fabricators Paul and Malala. *MISAOTRA BETSAKA!*

Ertice and his main assistant Lilyane have made us very proud! A sincere thank you goes out to all of you that participated in making this workshop such a success. We still need help to reach sustainability, so we welcome your involvement in 2023!

We were able to supply Ertice and his family with solar power this year, a complete game changer for any family in Madagascar. They are now able to have proper lighting at night and can charge their work devices at home, among many, many other conveniences.

...**MACOLLINE** extension is complete! Prior to this, the interpretation center (Welcome Hall) at MACOLLINE was just a small sized room with enough space for 10-15 students or adult teachers, standing, while the guide gave explanations. When I was there in June, we discussed extending the center to be able to fit more students comfortably with benches. And to accommodate Lilyane; the main MACOLLINE guide, with proper office space to do computer work etc.

Lilyane has already started teaching in the new space and it looks great with capacity now for at least 60 children! She also now has a comfortable and dry office space to do her clerical work, i.e.: reporting, creating lists of students and preparing certificates.

We are proud to thank **Sentrex** as well for participation in MACOLLINE pedagogy field trips for students, and for funding a new house and kitchen for the MACOLLINE guardian plus as a new latrine at the summit!





Aust & Hachmann Canada is currently funding an additional school (construction has already begun) in Antapolo, a vanilla growing village just outside of Antalaha. Preparation for the structure started in late October and weather permitting, the school should be ready by April/May **2023**.

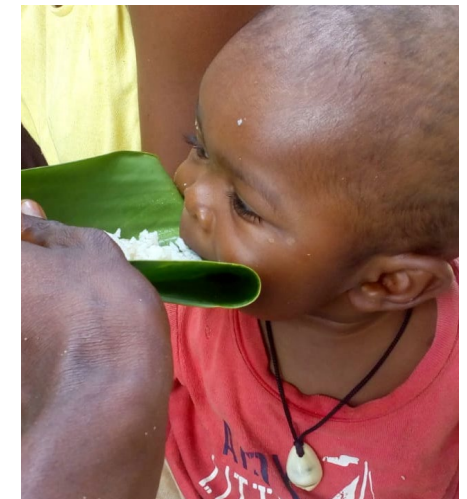
